This month we have had three days in which school was closed due to inclement weather. The protocol for St. Francis Xavier closing is that whenever Petoskey Public is in session and closes due to weather, SFX follows suit. The superintendent of Petoskey Schools in consultation with the director of transportation makes the determination if a closure is necessary based on road conditions.

Signing up for the Smart911 system, formerly BeAlert, is a quick and reliable tool for being informed of school closures. All of our school personnel use Smart911 for notices of school closures and learn of closings at the same time as parents that utilize this tool.
